### Graduate Schemes

#### What they are:

- A structured training programme
- A defined time: generally a year or two in length
- Available across a range of different sectors
- Available in different specialisms (e.g. HR, marketing, management)
- A way to experience different areas of a business
- Competitive
- Recruiting (in general) to start in September after graduation
- Normally open for applications between September and December.

#### What they are not:

- The only option!
- Impossible to get into lots of support is available
- Necessarily a guaranteed job at the end of the programme
- Only in corporate companies (also available in the NHS, some charities, TeachFirst).





# Application process

The application process for Graduate Schemes may have several elements:

- Online application
- Psychometric testing
  - Situational judgement
  - Numerical reasoning
  - Verbal reasoning
  - Critical thinking
- Assessment centres
  - Case studies
  - Teamwork
  - Presentations
  - In-tray exercises
- Interviews



#### Alternatives to Graduate Schemes

Graduate Schemes are the minority!

#### Graduate level roles:

- Require a degree (most roles are open to any degree discipline)
- Exist in all kinds of organisations and sectors
- Can be more flexible than Graduate Schemes
- Are recruited throughout the year
- Have a shorter recruitment process
- Are incredibly varied!
