## **Associate Research Students**

This policy concerns external PhD students who wish to perform part of their PhD project at our School. External means they are registered for a PhD at their home institution only, and they will return to it for finishing their degree.

#### Applying for associate study:

Applicants must submit an online application here:

https://www.qmul.ac.uk/postgraduate/associate/

Please allow sufficient time to apply before the intended start date.

### **Entry points:**

It is possible to start associate study at three points during the year:

- September
- Janaury
- May
- Other entry points may be considered with agreement from Admissions and the RDO.

Associate students can apply to study for up to 12 months.

#### **Entry requirements**

- Associate students must be currently enrolled on a PGR programme at another university.
- If English is not the applicant's first language, evidence of English language proficiency must be provided. Associates must meet a minimum requirement of IELTS 5.5 with no less than 5.5 in Reading, Writing, Listening and Speaking (or an equivalent approved test). Tests must have been taken within 2 years of your proposed start date.

### Supporting documentation

Associate applicants must provide the following supporting information:

- Completed online application form: <a href="https://www.qmul.ac.uk/postgraduate/associate/">https://www.qmul.ac.uk/postgraduate/associate/</a>
- Confirmation of student status letter from current institution, to include dates of registration.
- Degree transcripts.
- If degree was from a UK university, please upload a transcript of marks for each year.
- If degree was from an overseas institution, a transcript of your marks for each year of study should be provided and a copy of degree certificate together with a certified translation if the document is not in English. Please note that original documentation will be required before enrolment. International applicants are also advised to include high school transcripts.
- Statement of purpose. This should explain why applicant want to study on chosen programme and how it will help applicant's life and career.
- Curriculum Vitae (CV)/ Resume.
- English language test certificate (if applicable).
- International/EU applicants should provide evidence of English language ability: IELTS, TOEFL, or other acceptable proof. Please see the international students section for more details.

# **Academic Technology Approval Scheme (ATAS)**

Students who are not <u>EEA</u> or Swiss nationals may require <u>ATAS clearance</u> to undertake certain courses. Further information on ATAS can be found on our <u>Advice and Counselling webpages</u>.
