## Puzzle 8: list, enumerate

Consider the following examples:

- (1) Sarah listed who attended the party
- (2) Sarah enumerated who attended the party
- (3) \*Sarah listed if/whether John attended the party
- (4) \*Sarah enumerated if/whether John attended the party

List and enumerate can take content questions as a complement, but not yes/no questions. Why is that? In your answer, make sure you consider the semantics that our proposal in class gives to both *if/whether John attended the party* and *who attended the party*.

**Note on word count**. Examples, definitions, tests, etc. do not count towards the word count. You should aim for 600-700 words of prose per puzzle.
