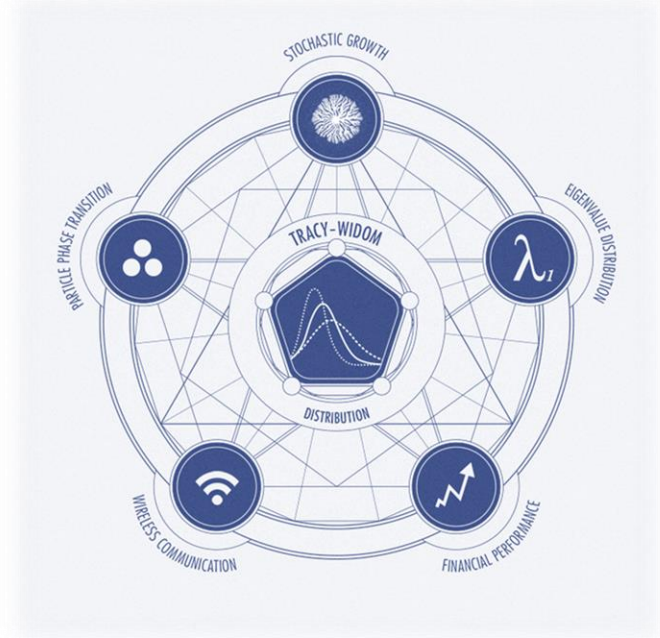

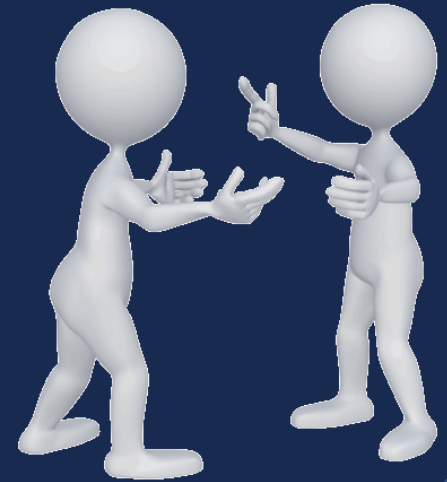
Developing a Personal Development Plan:

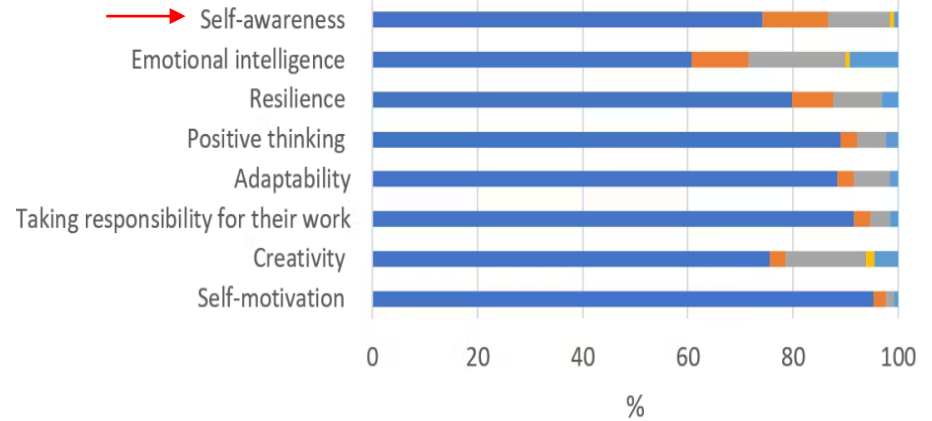
