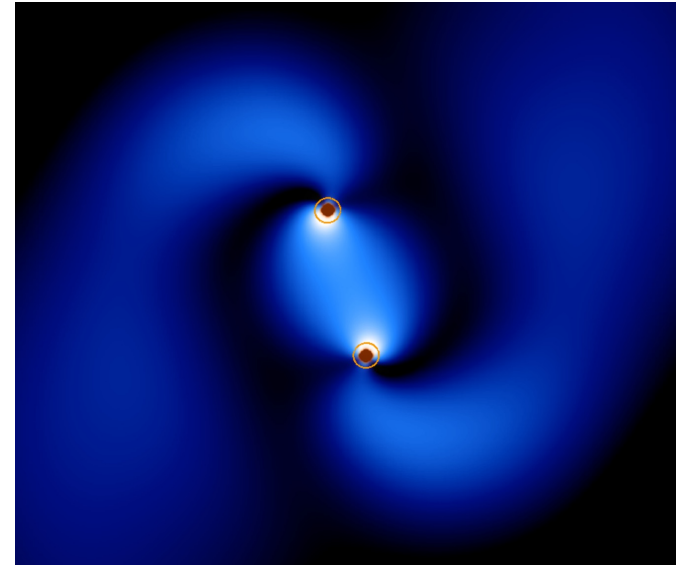


Postgraduate Research Studies in Maths (PhD) at QMUL



Few facts

- Doing a PhD means to do **exciting research**, to create **new Maths**
- Entry requirements: first class degree Honours in Maths or Statistics (ideally MSci, Mmath, MSc)
- You work with a supervisor on a project
- You can get paid! (3-4 years Scholarship)
- The PhD opens the door to the academic career but you can as well get a job outside academia.
- Application deadline end of January
