

Guidance for the MTH6113 exam

MTH6113 is an open book exam in the sense that you are allowed to **bring 3 A4 pages of notes to the exam**.

- As mentioned in class you need to make sure that these notes are comprehensive.
- I urge you to start working on these notes as soon as possible. Once they are ready you can start use them in solving the Specimen Paper (available on QMPlus), but also the all the Practice Sets that we have done in class. In this way you will be ready to use them efficiently during the exam.
- Also please remember that making the summary is a useful revision task in itself so do this yourself rather than using a friend's and write it out rather than just printing existing material.
- You don't need to condense the whole module onto 3 pages. Pick out the things you find hard to remember.
- One approach is to attempt a past/specimen paper without any notes and see which places you felt a reminder would have been useful.

So far there is one Specimen Paper with Solutions on QMPlus. I will add two more: one that we will solve together in class next week (Week 11) and one that we will solve in the last week of the term (Week 12).
