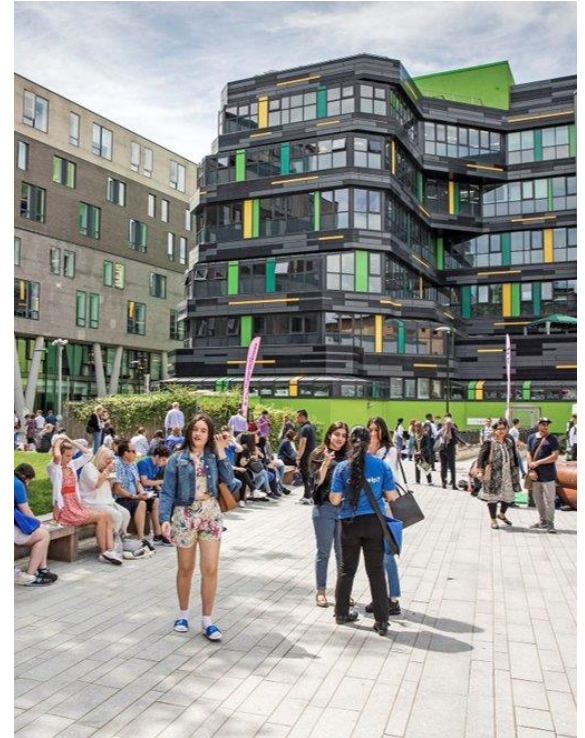

1. Communication Channels

- QMplus is one of the main ways for teaching staff to communicate with students, so please regularly check module announcements & forums
- For video conferencing:

- Office hours with lecturers/tutors
- Communicate with classmates for group work via MS Teams
- Student societies, university jobs etc... use Teams

2. Module content

- Each module will be different, depending on what the module leader has chosen to include, but most will be presented in a similar format and will include material such as;
 - Module outlines/module information block
 - Lecture slides
 - Tools for communicating such as discussion forums
 - Tabs & topics: videos, PowerPoint slides, other resources and materials
 - Online coursework such (e.g., assignments, quizzes)

3. Lecture Recordings – Q-Review



What is Q-Review?

- Our system for recording live teaching in lecture theatres with a capacity of 40+ students.
- Link to the recordings will be available on the QMplus module area.
- NB: Not all lecture theatre are Q-Review enabled.

Student Stats – Q-Review Use

4. Submitting assignments

- ❖ Timeline feature (found on your Dashboard) allows you to view all your upcoming deadlines

4. Submitting assignments

- Turnitin generates a similarity report and score (if enabled)
- Schools may choose to allow you to check your Turnitin score for your draft so you can check prior to submitting the assignments
 - *A high similarity score will not be immediately interpreted as a case of plagiarism; submissions will be read by subject experts*

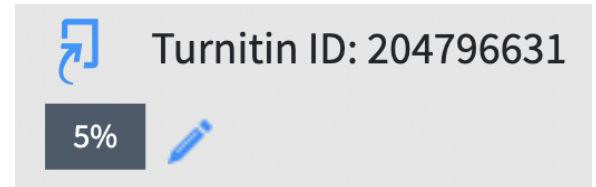
