# Faculty Development workshops – course booking until Summer 2025 now open

We continue to run **weekly faculty development workshops** on common themes for clinical teachers – "teaching on the run" this week, "giving feedback to learners" next week, etc. There are in-person and online options. You can look at the full list of topics and book to attend through the <u>course catalogue</u>. Anyone who teaches our students or is thinking about teaching our students is very welcome. Certificates of attendance are provided which map to the four commonest teaching portfolios.

## Keep an eye on your emails

We are trying to get everyone who is paid to teach our students a QMUL IT account via London. It is a bureaucratically challenging process, that may or may not be successful, but just in case, please do keep an eye out for emails from QMUL asking you to activate an account.

### Gathering student feedback

One essential component of a teaching portfolio is student (learner) feedback.

We have created a system for you to get rapid feedback from students straight to your inbox. You can create your own unique QR Code that takes the students to an online form already populated with your details. The students fill in their feedback and hit submit and 24hrs later an anonymised version arrives in your email inbox. A non-anonymised version arrives in the medical school in Gozo.



You can keep the QR code on your phone for small group and bedside teaching; and although it was initially intended for bedside teaching you can also add the QR code at the end of a lecture.

We designed it for use with QM/Barts students. If you use it with other students, please make sure that they know that a copy comes to us!
