- 4. Discuss the advantages and disadvantages of using crude death rates and age standardised in estimating the burden of disease in different countries.
- 5. The data in the paper is based on six countries and only on death rates. Discuss the limitations of such an approach for comparing the burden of cardiovascular disease and the quality of care in Africa and Europe.

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
