## Module Registration Guidance for First Year Students of Russian and Comparative Literature – 2023-24

Welcome to the School of Languages, Linguistics and Film (SLLF), here at Queen Mary University of London.

As a new first year student of Russian and Comparative Literature your 120 credits of modules are core/compulsory, meaning you do not have any optional module choices to make.

All students must take 120 credits (including your core/compulsory modules), over two semesters (Semester A: September – December and Semester B: January – April).

  - o RUS4201 Russian I [Post A-Level] (30 credits, Full Year, Level 4).
  - o RUS4202 Russian I N [Heritage/Native Speaker] (30 credits, Full Year, Level 4).
- SML4006 Culture and Language (30 credits, Full Year, Level 4).
- COM4207 The Scene of Learning (30 credits, Full Year, Level 4).
- COM4206 Introduction to Comparison (15 credits, Semester A, Level 4).
- COM4210 Understanding Culture: Exploring the Big Questions (15 credits, Semester B, Level 4).
