Module title: Catalan Culture: Art, Literature and Football

Content Description

This module offers a general introduction to modern and contemporary Catalan culture from the nineteenth to the twenty-first century. Topics covered include: nationalism; the politics of language; the avant--garde art of Salvador Dalí and Miró; literature; football. There is no language requirement for this module; therefore it is suitable for students with no knowledge of Catalan and Spanish.

Module Aims

- 1. The aims for this module at Level 5 are to introduce the notion of regional cultural identity in this case Catalan as represented by a variety of cultural phenomena: art, poetry, the novel, critical writing, football. The module thus presents Catalan culture as an interaction of different strands, against a sociopolitical background.
- 2. Moreover, various artistic/literary styles are presented as a means of understanding the culture analysed: for example, Naturalism, Symbolism, and Surrealism.

Learning Outcomes

Academic Content:

A1 Acquire a basic outline-knowledge of modern Catalan culture.

A2 Be aware of different artistic currents in relation to Catalan culture.

A3 Understand how regional identity is formed by culture.

A4 Understand how interpretative methods derived from artistic styles can help us understand culture.
