

Module Registration Guidance for First Year Students of Linguistics – 2024-25

Welcome to the School of The Arts (STA), here at Queen Mary University of London.

As a new first year student of Linguistics your 120 credits of modules are core/compulsory, meaning you do not have any optional module choices to make.

All students must take 120 credits (including your core/compulsory modules), over two semesters (Semester A: September – December and Semester B: January – April).

As a first year student, you are required to take the following core/compulsory module(s):

- LIN4207 Thinking Linguistics: Approaches to Writing and Analysis (15 credits, Semester A, Level 4).
- LIN4208 Foundations of Language (30 credits, Semester A, Level 4).
- LIN4212 Phonetics I: The Sounds of English (15 credits, Semester A, Level 4).
- LIN4209 Syntax I: The Structure of English (15 credits, Semester B, Level 4).
- LIN4210 Phonology I: Introduction to Sound Systems (15 credits, Semester B, Level 4).
- LIN4211 Sociolinguistics: English in Use (15 credits, Semester B, Level 4).
- LIN4213 Typology I: Languages of the World (15 credits, Semester B, Level 4).
