Content Description

The first-year language module constitutes a core element of all degrees including French in their titles. It is taught throughout two semesters and has the value of 30 credits. FRE4200 French I is generally available to students with an A or B at A-levels in French or equivalent (post A level pathway). Students must pass the first-year core language module in order to progress to their second year of study.

The three years in French language (Level 4 to 6) form a coherent and integrated programme which takes students from various levels in French (complete beginner, post-GCSE or post A-level) to graduate standard (C2 of the European Framework of Reference for Languages). The first-year post A-level pathway course aims at providing a sound basis in oral and written communication (comprehension and expression) with an emphasis on grammar, structure of language, acquisition of vocabulary and analysis.
