Content Description

This Level 6 language module constitutes a core element of all degrees involving French. It is mandatory for all students in their final year, whether Single Honours or Joint Honours students and whether or not they have spent a period of residence abroad. It is taught throughout two semesters and has the value of 30 credits. It is a preparation for the Final Year Examination.

Module Aims

By the end of this course, students will be able to:

- better understand French texts written in a variety of registers and express this understanding analytically and critically in written and spoken French
- adopt and follow a well-defined plan based on sound structure and argumentation
- approach translation more systematically, displaying understanding of the text and its context, its style and tone
- present a short talk on a chosen topic with ease and fluency in a well-structured way in both formal and informal registers
- express themselves with increased confidence in both written and oral French
