## Content Description

This module is designed to enable final-year students to pursue a sustained piece of individual research on an agreed topic that may not necessarily be covered in the taught programme. Students are required to have completed LIN5202 Research Methods in Linguistics (or equivalent) and be familiar with best practices in conducting and presenting original language research. The module is designed as a seminar, and students will be expected to generate and present various portions of their research in class throughout the semester.

- gained experience in conducting original academic research, working independently, and exploring their own academic/intellectual interests,
- built on your existing knowledge base and further develop what you have learned so far in their degree
- developed a wider set of transferrable skills.
