Content Description

In the Research Project in Translation, final-year students will acquire the background knowledge and skills to produce the translation of a previously untranslated text from one of the languages studied within their degree into English, and a commentary addressing their overall approach and strategy for rendering into appropriate English a source emanating from a different culture. A series of workshops will provide training in the relevant methodologies and theories, to enable students to implement meaningful translation choices. Students should approach a supervisor with suitable expertise to oversee their project in meetings scheduled regularly throughout the year.

Develop knowledge and understanding of translation methods and theories as they apply to their own project
