### Process for selecting

- Pre-register on MySIS by **Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> April** (places limited)
- Names randomly selected (if oversubscribed)
- Informed if allocated a place by **Friday 5<sup>th</sup> April**

### Payment Information

- Deposit is required (**£150**)
- Deposit invoices issued in **July 2024** for **GEG5152 (Belfast)**
- Balance invoices issued after fieldtrip in 2024/25

- You will lose your place on the fieldtrip if you don't follow the instructions (it will be offered to the next student on the waiting list)





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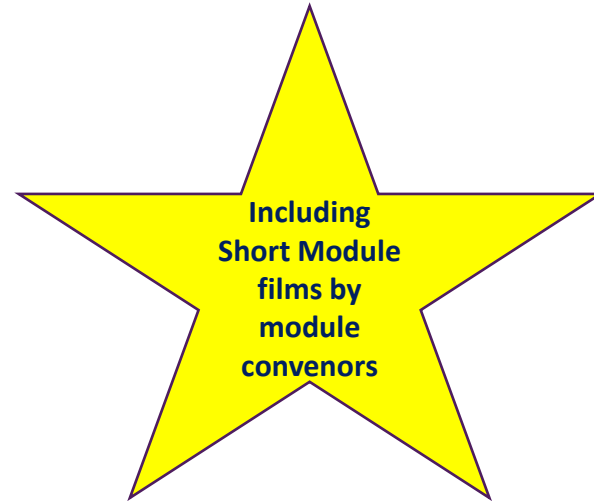
