- Graduate Schemes (2 -3 year paid training programmes often rotational)
- Internships (4 weeks to 1 year paid work experience)
- Other Graduate Jobs (general entry level jobs)

Career Masterclass - Overview of UK Finance/Economics Job Market Graduate Schemes

- Offered by most large organisations
- Rotational training programmes (1-3 years)
- Usually start around September
- Applications open around September the previous year (Investment Banks even earlier the sooner you
 apply the higher your chances!)

- Most large organisations have Internships
- Usually over the summer
- Often just for penultimate year students but some accept Master students (read carefully before applying)
- Employers also offer off-cycle Internships
- Smaller employers call any work experience internships, which is usually open to all applicants

- If you do not get on to a Graduate Scheme, there are many other graduate roles available.
- It is important to stay flexible and open-minded

Most graduate jobs are not graduate training schemes!
