## Module Registration Guidance for First Year Students of French and Comparative Literature – 2024-25

Welcome to the School of The Arts (STA), here at Queen Mary University of London.

As a new first year student of French and Comparative Literature your 120 credits of modules are core/compulsory, meaning you do not have any optional module choices to make.

All students must take 120 credits (including your core/compulsory modules), over two semesters (Semester A: September – December and Semester B: January – April).

## **Your Modules**

As a first year student, you are required to take the following core/compulsory module(s):

- Depending on your language level, you will be placed onto ONE of the following:
  - o FRE4204 Introductory French [Beginners] (30 credits, Full Year, Level 4).
  - o FRE4202 French I Intensive [Post GCSE] (30 credits, Full Year, Level 4).
  - o FRE4200 French I [Post A-Level] (30 credits, Full Year, Level 4).
- SML4006 Culture and Language (30 credits, Full Year, Level 4).
- COM4212 Knowledge and Power (30 credits, Full Year, Level 4).
- COM4211 Beyond Compare: Literature Across Borders (15 credits, Semester A, Level 4).
- COM4213 Understanding Global Cultures: Exploring the Big Questions (15 credits, Semester B, Level 4).
