# Research & grants: getting ready for 2022-23

Town hall meeting, 8th June 2022

#### Context

- The Faculty of S&E is undergoing changes in its research support provision.
- There has also been a shift in the expectations towards research, grant activity and PhD supervision.
- In general, there is a move towards more centralisation (general idea: pool resources)

#### Faculty research themes

- Green energy
- Biodiversity & environment
- Al & data modelling
- Engineering better medicine
- Social interaction, mental health & well-being

## Why care?

- Coordinate the recruitment and training of PhD cohorts
- Develop content for external profile (website etc)
- Build industrial engagement coordinating with BD and QMI
- Stimulate large collaborative grant applications
- Support the recruitment of new research staff
- Building Leadership Teams
- Mapping Research in Schools to Themes, URIs, Highways, etc.

## Research highways

- Accelerating Innovation & Invention
- Life, long health & well being
- Performance, Communication & Creative industries
- Digital information and data
- Sustainability, environment & energy

## Questions for the audience

## Grant activity

- There is a general movement to increase the grant income volume in the Faculty. Ambitious targets are being set for the end of the decade (£49k fte/y in 2022 —> ~£100k fte/y for SMS)
- Accordingly, more attention is being to the grant activity of individuals across the Faculty.
- PhD studentships regarded as leverage for grant applications. General idea: PhD studentships only for staff with live grants.
- Expectation of a grant submission per year as PI.

#### To do list for the audience

- Start thinking about suitable PhD projects.
- Can I link PhD projects to research themes? Can I provide a credible plan for grant activity for my PhD project?
- Can I use my China contacts to attract applicants for the CSC scheme?
- How can I integrate grant writing in my yearly academic routine?
- Can I write a bid which is not for EPSRC? What alternative funding sources are there?
